

# **AnimeNZ ART COMPETITION**

## **RULES FOR ART COMPETITION**

- 1 – Work must be submitted on paper or card, from A4 to A3 size.
- 2 – The basis of the work must be HAND DRAWN with pencil or inking tools. Work can then be inked, coloured or painted over, as seen fit. CGI media or medium is not permitted, nor will we accept submissions on electronic media (eg. on a CD).  
Why hand drawn? - This is because we wish to be able to easily establish the skills of the artist, and we feel it is easier to judge directly with work done by a given artist's hand, as well as setting a consistent level of medium as not all artists have easy access to specialized CGI equipment.
- 3 – Parody doujinshi and original artwork is acceptable.
- 4 – Art competition entries will be on display to the public at Doujin Overload 2010, and therefore all works should be produced at a PG rating level, so it is suitable for a general audience.
- 5 – Any picture or theme may be offered for entry, in either colour or black & white; but the work should be anime/mangastyled or influenced. If there any reasonable doubt of this, please consult/contact an authorized representative of Anime NZ on the possible suitability of your work for this particular competition.
- 6 – The FULL NAME of the applicant needs to be written on back of the submitted work for identification purposes.
- 7 – If you wish to enter but are not in the greater Auckland region, you can mail/courier your application. If the work is a mailed application, and the owner/applicant wishes work to be returned, the work needs to be included with a self-addressed courier bag.

Note: While all reasonable care will be taken, the organizers of this event accept no responsibility for any damage or loss in relation to any artwork submitted.
